NOTICE is hereby given that the Borough Council of the Borough of Everson, Fayette County, Pennsylvania, intends to adopt an ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 149, AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF OPENING AND EXCAVATING OF STREETS, ALLEYS, SIDEWALKS AND OTHER PUBLIC GROUNDS, COMMONLY KNOWN AS A TRENCHING ORDINANCE ON ALL ROADS, ALLEYS AND PUBLIC GROUNDS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF EVERSON, FAYETTE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, at a regular meeting of the Council to be held on March 17, 2020, at 6:30 P.M., at the Everson Borough Municipal Building, 232 Brown Street, Everson, PA 15631.

The title and text of the Ordinance are as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 203

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF EVERSON, COUNTY OF FAYETTE, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 149, COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE "TRENCHING ORDINANCE."

WHEREAS, the Borough of Everson desires to amend the Trenching Ordinance of Everson Borough to adopt a more thorough restoration of the streets and alleys and to provide adopt new fees.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF EVERSON BOROUGH, COUNTY OF FAYETTE, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Short Title: This ordinance shall be known and cited as "First Amendment to the Trenching Ordinance of Everson Borough."

Section 2. : Section 5 of the Trenching Ordinance of Everson Borough is amended to include the following sections:

b. When repaving is done pursuant to this Ordinance, said paving shall be from curb to curb, and not merely over the trench.

c. Repaving of the street or alley shall be completed within fourteen (14) days of the date that the street or alley is opened. In the event that the work is done in winter months such that it is not possible to permanently repave the street or alley, then cold patch shall be applied and maintained as provided for in Section 7(j) of this Ordinance.

Section 3: Schedule A to the Trenching Ordinance is amended as follows:



| 6. New Construction: | Subsurface and Surface Facility Installations (e.g. pipe lines, buried cable – with pedestals, conduit, manhole, headwell, inlet, grate, testholes) |
| a. Physically connected facility or facilities of less than 3 square yards in length (each section) | \$100.00 |
| b. Each additional section of 2 square yards or fraction thereof. | \$5.00 per square yard |
| 7. Repairs: Facility Openings (e.g. service connections If performed independently; pipeline repairs) each Opening of less than 3 square yards and \$5.00 per square yard for each additional section of 2 square yards or fraction thereof. | \$100.00 |
| 8. Crossings: This would include “Overhead” tipples, Conveyors, pedestrian walkways and “Undergrade” subways or mines. | \$200.00 |
| 9. Seismograph – Vibrosis Method, including prospecting for oil, gas, etc. | |
| a. First mile | \$125.00 |
| b. Each additional mile or fraction thereof | \$15.00 |
| 10. Moving objects across the street (e.g. draglines, houses) | \$100.00 |


Section 4: This Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days from the date of its adoption.




